# Infection **Prevention** and Control

The wearing of hand/wrist jewellery increases the bacterial load on hands and impedes effective hand decontamination.

For manual handling there is real potential for skin tears resulting in damage.

### **Manual Handling**

Food handlers must adhere to the bare elbows (BBE) principle.
