Philip	 Philip will talk to the Governors about two important decisions. 1 Quality Account – Governors have seen our draft quality account and will write a statement about whether they support what has been written. The Quality Account presents information about how the quality of services was measured and monitored over the last 12 months. 2. How many Governors do we have? Governors have discussed some changes and the Trust's Board of Directors have looked the proposed changes and
	made suggestions about the type of staff governor and including someone from the Voluntary sector. The Governors will be agreeing the final number and type of Governors. Once they agree the revised number and type of Governor, the Trust will start the search to find and elect Governors. Governors are keen to have some younger Governors and to give as many people as possible the chance to become a Governor. Our members will get the chance to vote who they want to be their Governor in the Summer elections.
